# **ABANTEL™** BROAD SPECTRUM WORMER FOR DOGS

ACTIVE CONSTITUENTS: Each tablet contains - 545mg OXANTEL EMBONATE, 140mg PYRANTEL EMBONATE and 50mg PRAZIQUANTEL

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

For oral use only. Can be administered directly into the mouth or crushed and mixed with the feed.

1 tablet per 10kg bodyweight.

Dogs up to 5kg should be given half (1/2) a tablet.

#### Dosage table:

Bodyweight	Dose
up to 5kg	½ tablet
10kg	1 tablet
20kg	2 tablets
30kg	3 tablets
40kg	4 tablets
50kg	5 tablets

Specific treatment for *Spirometra* erinacei is by administering ABANTEL™ BROAD SPECTRUM WORMER FOR DOGS four (4) times the above dose rate.

## GENERAL DIRECTIONS ROUNDWORMS & HOOKWORMS:

Treat at 2, 4, 8 and 12 weeks - thereafter every 3 months.

**WHIPWORMS:** Treat every 6-8 weeks after 3 months of age.

**HYDATID TAPEWORM:** Dogs should not be fed, or allowed to feed on, offal from any species. Dogs in hydatid areas should be treated every 6 weeks.

**OTHER TAPEWORMS:** Treat every 3months.

**PREGNANT BITCHES:** Treat at mating, before whelping and then every 3 months.

For Dipylidium treatment adequate flea control should be maintained all year around.

#### **DISPOSAL**

Dispose of empty container by wrapping with paper and placing in garbage.

#### **STORAGE**
