Empty poultry sheds, free from litter, manure and portable equipment	100mL per 10L water	Remove all animals and birds before use. Empty all water and feed containers. Saturate all surfaces. Clean all water feed containers before re-use. Ventilate area thoroughly before entry.

General Directions

Do not use this product on feed or water.

PROTECTION OF LIVESTOCK

Do not allow animals or birds back into the area until treatment has been absorbed or has dried and area is adequately ventilated.

PROTECTION OF WILDLIFE, FISH, CRUSTACEA AND ENVIRONMENT

Toxic to fish. Do not directly contaminate ponds, rivers or waterways with this chemical or used containers. This product is biodegradable and ultimately breakdown in the presence of organic matter.

STORAGE

Store in a closed, original container in a cool, well-ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight.

DISPOSAL

Triple-rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point.

If not recycling, break, crush, or puncture and deliver empty packaging to an approved waste management facility. If an approved waste management facility is not available, bury the empty packaging 500 mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose, clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant local, state or territory government regulations. Do not burn empty containers or product.

SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Poisonous if absorbed by skin contact or swallowed. Corrosive. Attacks eyes. Will irritate the nose and throat and skin. Repeated exposure may cause allergic disorders. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale vapour or spray mist. When opening the container and preparing the solution wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat, elbow length butyl rubber gloves, face shield or goggles, impervious footwear and half facepiece respirator with combined dust and gas cartridge. When using the prepared solution wear cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and a washable hat, elbow-length butyl rubber gloves, impervious footwear, face-shield or goggles. If product on skin, immediately wash area with soap and water. If product in eyes, wash it out immediately with water. After use and before eating, drinking or smoking, wash hands, arms and face thoroughly with soap and water. After each day's use, wash gloves, face shield or goggles and respirator (If rubber wash with detergent and warm water) and contaminated clothing.

FIRST AID INSTRUCTIONS
